Congress Results

Manchester 4 - 6 July

There was an increase of 20% in numbers for this popular congress directed by Harry Lamb. There were three sections. In the **Open**: $1^{\rm st}$ was Prasun Chakraorty (Sheffield Nomads) on $4\frac{1}{2}$, followed by El Gehani Ghassan (Withington Peoples) on 4, and in $3-5^{\rm th}$ places Dan Masson (Shirley), Mithran Chakravorty (Sheffield University) and Leo Keely (Withington Peoples). In the **Major**: six players shared places $1^{\rm st}-6^{\rm th}$ by Martin Burns (Stockport), Carl Heald (Morcambe), Andy Price (Leamington), Mark Taylor (Rochdale), David Boulden (Stalybridge) and Philip Olbison (Chorlton) all with $4\frac{1}{2}$ points. In the **Knights** section: $1^{\rm st}$ was Noel Boustred (Gosforth) with $4\frac{1}{2}$, $2^{\rm nd}-3^{\rm rd}$ were Daniel Broughton (West Bridgeford) and Colin Sinclair (Preston West) with $4\frac{1}{2}$.


Leicester All-Play-All 23/24/25 Aug and 6/7 Sep

An international field of 20 players participated in this FIDE rated all play all. **Group A** was dominated by juniors as 1st and unbeaten on 7/9 was 12 year old Brandon Clarke (Littlethorpe) with a TPR of 2236 gaining 80 rating points, 2nd was 16 year old James Jackson (Red Dragons) 6½. In **Group B**: 1st was Chris Jones (Kettering) on 6½/9, followed by 2nd= Mark Lim (Cambridge) and Nasrul Humaimi (Malaysia & Warwick University) each on 5½. All the unrated players were successful in achieving a full FIDE rating at this event.

Hereford 23 - 5 Aug

Grading prizes: Ray Collett (Worcester) and RE Jones (Swansea) with 3½. Minor: 1st-2nd, G Darling (Newton Abbott) and Alex Freeland jnr (Cardiff), 5, followed by Ken Alexander (Tiverton), Alexander Harris (Perse School), and John Loynes (Worcester, Stourbridge) all on 4½. Grading prize: Hazel Welch (Seaton) with 4.

Leek 12 - 14 Sep

After a one-year break, Roger Edwards was back in charge at Leek. In this "stars barred" event, there were three sections all sponsored by local enterprises. The format was a little unusual with just the single time-control to finish the game. This seems a good idea because it simplifies the controller's work and setting the clocks. Also, controllers placed players in sections strictly according to grade leading to close finishes in each section

Alton Towers (U210): This section saw a tie for top slot between: David Hulmes (Stockport), Oliver Jackson (Cheshire & N Wales), Peter Anderson (Leeds) all on 4/5.

AH Brooks, Solicitors (U132): David Boulden (Denton) and Paul Smith (Brighton & Hove) shared the top two prizes with 4½ points followed by Mark Radford (Navigation) and Jon Blackburn (Holmes Chapel).

Moorlands Housing (U97): Derrick Jones (Newcastle-u-Lyme) was first with 4½, followed by Samuel Onions (Newcastle-u-Lyme) and Matthew Wyza (Cheddleton & Leek).

Alan Smith (Cheddleton & Leek) received the prize for best player from the N Staffs League and Newcastle-u-Lyme won the team prize.
