IN MY OPINION

A Very Happy New Year to all Midland Chess Players | In this Issue you'll find a feature on Junior Chess. To anyone who has the interests of local juniors at heart it makes disturbing reading. When are the interests of the Children going to be put before those of the Emperors and Empire Builders ? when will the Midland Juniors get what they diserve - the best Competitions and the best coaching in the country. Do we as an area always want to be second best or are we prepared to start working for a better future ? You are the members tell me what you think and what you would like to see happen. Certainly the present situation cannot be for the best. The Association Secretary, in his final year, hits the nail on the head lets hope his words hit home in the right high places.

There is a growing tendancy in Sport for players to challenge those trying to organize events claiming bias or downright cheating. It is difficult to see how cheating could take place in a chess tournament since to win you must score more points than your opponents, and I've never yet seen a controller intervene to call "no move" or some such phrase when the favoured player loses a piece. Despite this I actually witnessed a strong Midland player, who should have known better, throw a tantrum when the final round pairings in a competition were announced. To his eternal shame a BCF arbiter present did not back the controllers and player power won another victory - What price volunteer tournament controllers in 1988 ?
